- I have been admitted to Minneapolis College as an international F-1 student for courses in the Fall 2020 academic term that will not be able to meet face-to-face due to temporary social distancing requirements.
- I am informed that the online format is a temporary measure in response to COVID-19 restrictions and that courses will return to a face-to-face format when restrictions are relaxed, and it is deemed safe to resume the traditional format.
- While I am assured that I may be able to complete the current semester on-line, future semesters may require my presence on campus in classrooms in the United States.
- I understand that consistent access to internet and a computer in good working order are the minimum equipment and technology requirements to participate in online courses. Other requirements for software necessary for specific programs are my responsibility to obtain, if applicable. I understand that a synchronous online course may require my presence in class via Zoom which may happen in the middle of the night in my time zone.
- I understand that Minneapolis College will support my request for a student visa to enter the United States when face-to-face course formats are reinstated but that the college has no control over the issuance of visas to enter the United States. I understand that I will need to obtain a student visa for Spring 2021 and will schedule an interview at the embassy as soon as appointments are available.
- I assume the risk that I may not be able to complete any Minneapolis College coursework beyond the current semester if I am not able to enter the United States to undertake face-to-face courses when the university deems it safe to return to this traditional format. I understand that successfully completed courses would potentially be available for transfer to another institution based on the policies of that institution.
- I understand that tuition is due August 3, if I register for a class before August 3. If I register for a class between August 4 and 21, tuition is due at the time I register. Classes start August 24. For most fall 2020 classes, the last day to ask for a refund is August 28, 2020. After August 28, there will be no refund of any kind even if I do not finish the class or withdraw from the class.
