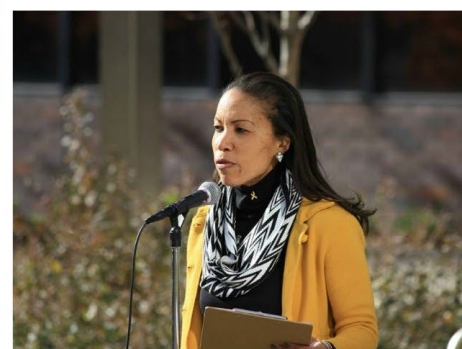

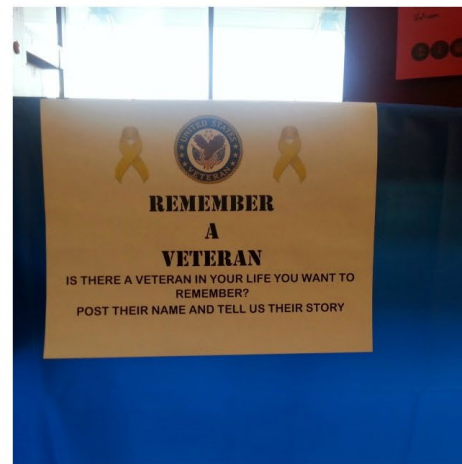
Yellow Ribbon - Objective

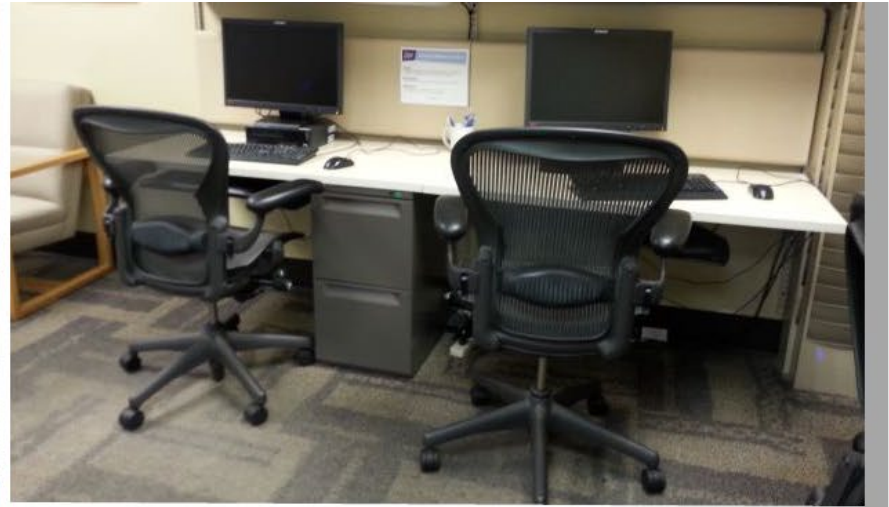

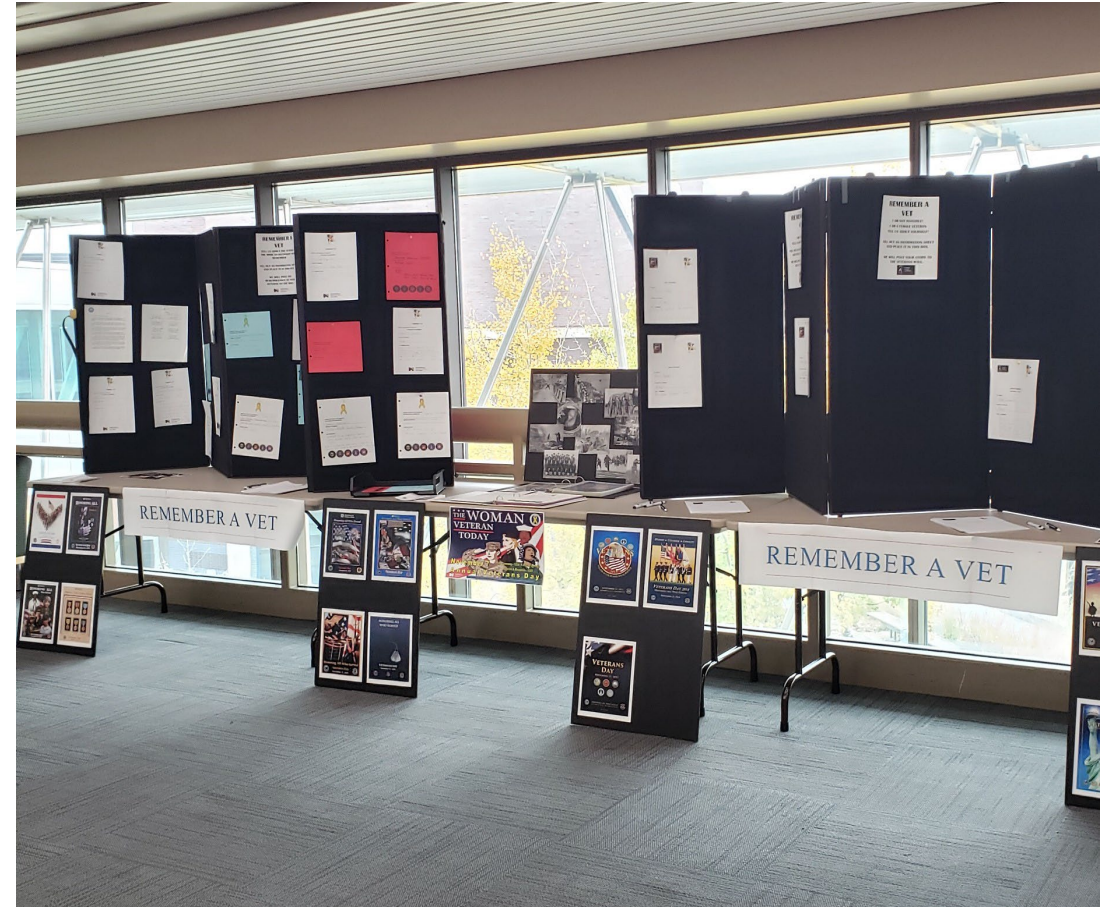

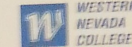
